Fifteen members of the Kurdish Children and Youth Music Group from Kurdistan are coming for their only premier performance to San Diego. Currently living in Amed (Diyarbakir), they are coming to California to perform in San Francisco and San Diego.

They are 15 girls and boys from 8 to 16 years of age.

This is an amazing and committed group of young people singing in their native Kurdish, plus in Armenian, Hebrew, Assyrian, Russian, to a total of eight languages. All of the group members play percussion instruments of davul, darbuka and

arbane, in addition to the lute tembur. Coming originally from the most disadvantaged parts of Amed they have successfully performed in numerous festivals throughout the region to great acclaim.
